1. WHAT'S NEW FOR RECONCILOR 9.5.5

Reconcilor by Snowden Optiro is a software solution designed to consolidate and integrate the knowledge and data provided by mining engineers, geologists, metallurgists, and planners. By standardising operations across multiple mining sites, Reconcilor enables advanced analysis and offers guidance to troubleshoot and optimise these sites.

As a Commercial Off-the-Shelf (COTS) offering, Reconcilor provides a ready-to-use solution that can be implemented without extensive customisation or development. It is designed to enhance and potentially replace previous versions of the product by offering additional functionality and improvements.

Reconcilor serves as a valuable tool for key stakeholders involved in mining operations, both on-site and at head office. It provides them with a comprehensive view of how operations are performing, allowing them to quickly identify any issues and receive early notifications. With this information at their disposal, stakeholders can take prompt action to resolve problems and improve overall operational efficiency.

This is a **minor version** update for Reconcilor. It is focused on resolution of the following:

- Chromium release which caused breaking changes on the Reconcilor management screens
- Stockpile delta comparison values were intermittently deleted
- Stockpile modelling algorithm LIFO Average was creating empty attribute sets







2. **RESOLUTIONS**

2.1 Latest Chromium release (used in Chrome and Edge) caused a breaking change

- Import Activity screen inconsistent return of imported records
- Import Activity screen freezing and greying out

Problem: Chromium, being used in the Chrome and Edge browsers has had an unpublicised internal change that cause change detection and rendering behaviour which caused a breaking change on the management screens used in Reconcilor. This affects all versions of Reconcilor 9. Users were reporting the following issues:

- Add Import Job button was unresponsive
- Records returned when looking at the details of an import job were not representative of the import
- The import history was not being listed for the date parameters
- The import activity screen was regularly greyed out so that nothing was working

Resolution: Minor changes were made to the code on the import activity screen to get the screen functioning as expected.

Upgrade Instructions: No specific actions are required to benefit from this bug fix. The update will automatically be applied during this upgrade.

2.2 Stockpile delta comparison values

• Stockpile delta comparison values are intermittently deleted

Problem: It was reported that stockpile delta comparison values were being unexpectedly deleted. The deletion is triggered when specific stockpile updates are performed which trigger updates to historic comparison values.

Resolution: Rather than affecting all stockpiles over time, the updates are now correctly filtering by stockpile and date.

Upgrade Instructions: No specific actions are required to benefit from this bug fix. The update will automatically be applied during this upgrade.

2.3 LIFO Average Stockpiles creating empty attribute sets

• Stockpile modelling algorithm LIFO Average

Problem: The Reconcilor engine is creating stockpile balances assigned to attribute sets that are empty.

Resolution: The engine now ignores stockpiles where attribute sets are empty.

Upgrade Instructions: No specific actions are required to benefit from this bug fix. The update will automatically be applied during this upgrade.


